

Clean-Up, Prep & Repair Crew

Position Description:

Working alone or with other volunteers, you'll assist in preparing various education materials or clean-up activities. Responsibilities may include tracing, folding, stapling, cutting colouring or gluing education resources; sweeping, raking, shoveling outdoors; disinfecting and cleaning various program supplies; or testing and repairing rental equipment.

Qualifications:

- Ability to withstand repetitive actions.
- Ability to cut along the dotted line.
- Enthusiasm for a little creativity and a tidy workspace.
- Must complete a criminal record and vulnerable sector check prior to first shift.
- Willingness to get a little dirty and/or sweaty through manual labour activities.

Training:

On-the-job training is provided.

Typical Shift Availability:

- Year-round.
- Weekdays, weekends or evenings on third Thursday of each month.
- Daytime shifts broken into 3-hour segments (9:45am-12:45pm; 12:45pm-3:45pm).
- Evening shifts on third Thursday of the month (6:00-8:00pm).
