

Education Program Assistant

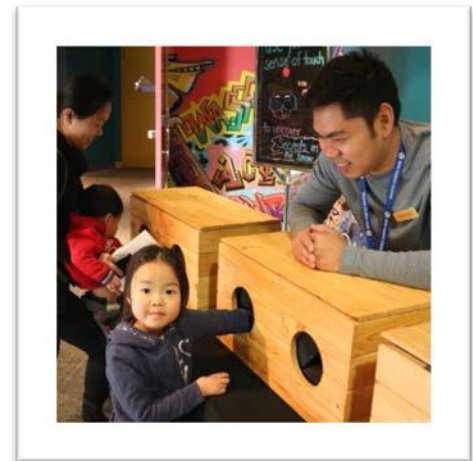
Armed with a script and education resources, lead groups of 10-25 youth through various activities focused on Alberta’s air, land, water and biodiversity. You’ll assist in helping youth to find the correct answers to activities - often helping with spelling too.

Current program opportunities:

Badge Groups (ages 5-12):	Fish, water or nature themes every 3 rd Thursday
Grade 3 (ages 7-8):	Life cycle stages
Grade 5 (ages 9-10):	Wetlands and invertebrates
What’s Up Wednesdays (families):	Different nature theme ever 1 st Wednesday

Qualifications:

- Ability to help maintain a respectful learning atmosphere.
- An engaging and welcoming personality.
- Enjoy working with younger age groups (typically ages 6-12).
- Must complete a clear criminal record and vulnerable sector check prior to first shift.
- *Experience in teaching or working with youth groups, not necessary but considered an asset.*



Reports to:

School Program Coordinator.

Training:

- One mandatory training session required (approx. 3 hours) focused on specific learning activities and their objectives for each grade/age group.
- Tips and strategies for engaging with various age groups, and methods for maintaining a respectful learning atmosphere will also be provided.

Typical Shift Availability:

- Year-round.
- Tuesdays-Fridays; extra help regularly required on first Wednesday of each month.
- Shifts depend on the time of year, expected visitor volume and booked programs.
- Evening shifts on third Thursday of the month (6:00-8:00pm).
- Typically morning shifts, broken into 3-hour segments (9:30am-12:30pm; 12:30pm-3:30pm).
